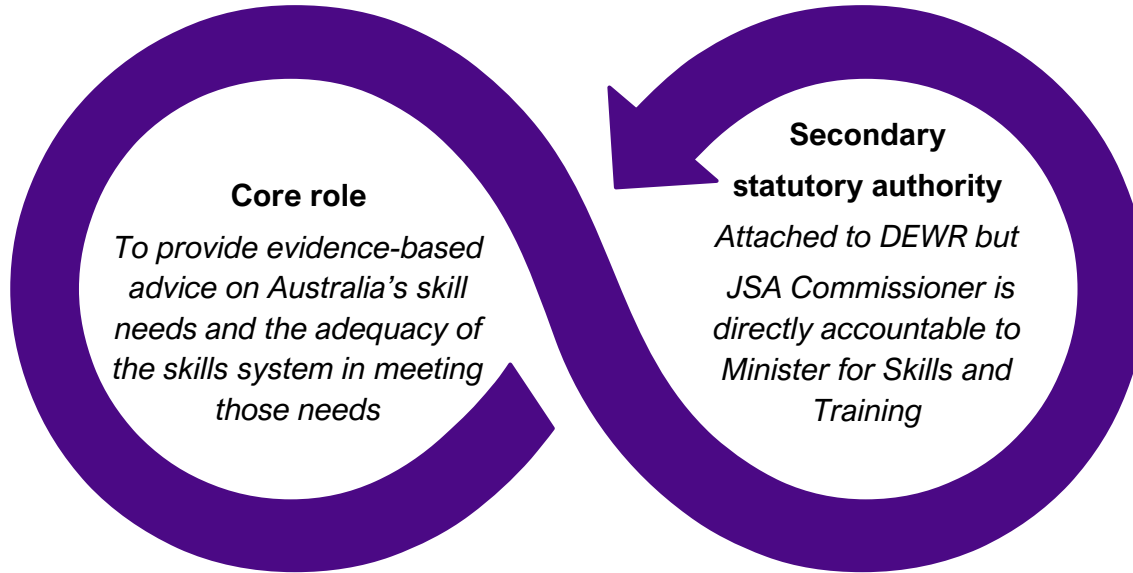

The Core Role of JSA



Tripartite engagement



Consultative Forum

Provide strategic advice to the Commissioner on the annual workplan, mechanisms for meaningful stakeholder engagement, and JSA's workforce capacity studies, cohort analyses or detail regional assessments



State and Territory Working Group

Helping inform and shape Jobs and Skills Australia 2023-24 work plan and furthering the conversation on areas for collaboration with States and Territories.



Jobs and Skills Councils

Two-way flow of intelligence with JSA providing national level labour market information and analysis to JSCs and JSCs in turn providing detailed intelligence of sectoral labour market developments as input into JSA products like the Skills Priority List.

Data products used and created by JSA: Overview

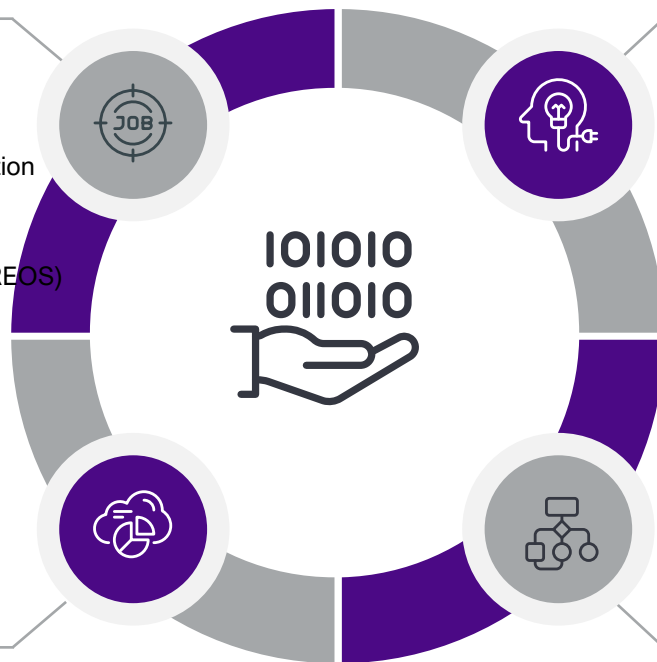
Jobs and Skills Australia produces data insights on current and future supply and demand of jobs and skills, education and training activity, outcomes from education and training, and labour market transitions using data collected by other agencies (e.g. Australian Bureau of Statistics, National Centre for Vocational Education Research) and in-house.

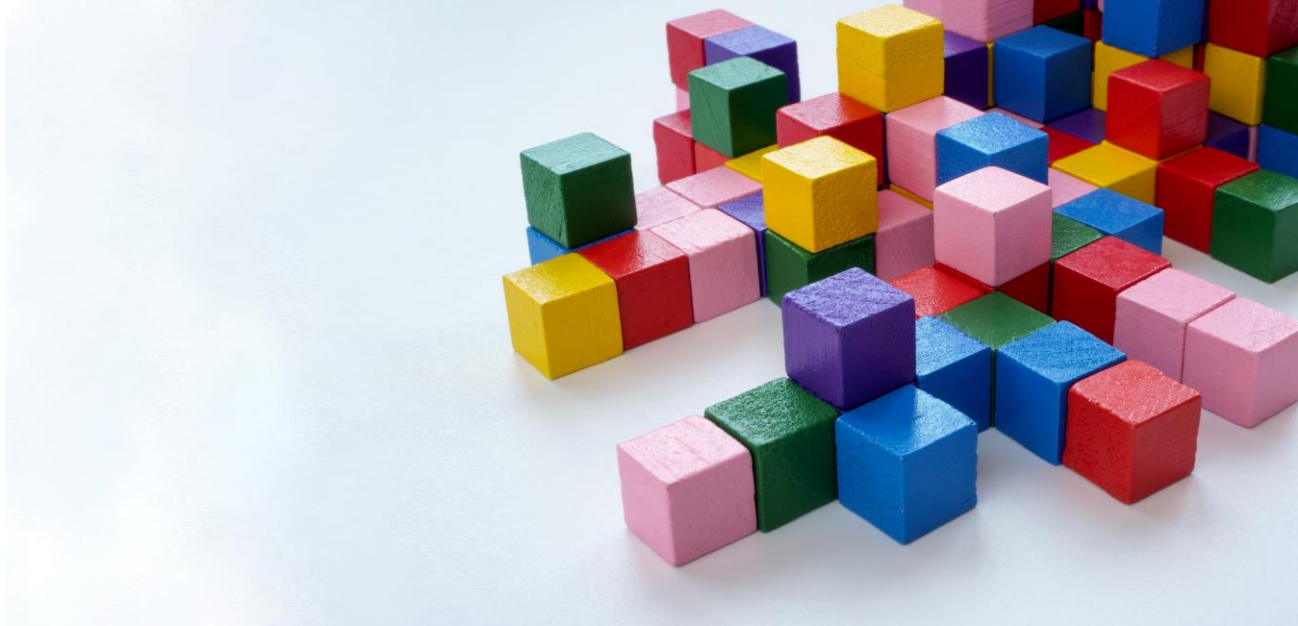

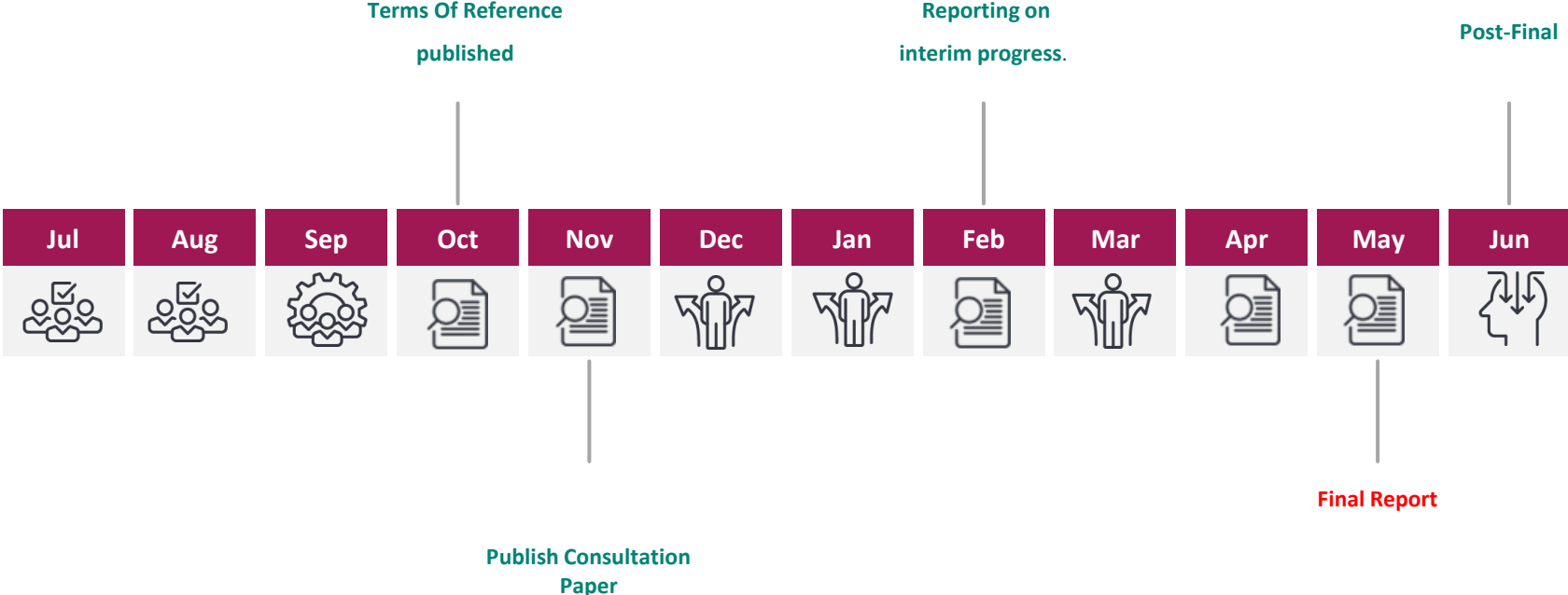
