Qualifications and Skills	 Individuals must either: hold a relevant 'Qualified educator' (or higher) qualification that appears on the <u>list</u> of approved qualifications for working with children over preschool age in Western Australia; or hold a qualification determined by ACECQA as equivalent to the qualifications required for a 'Qualified educator' (or higher) working with children over preschool age in Western Australia.
Employment Experience	 For applicants applying for a Temporary Skills Shortage (TSS) (subclass 482) visa or Skilled Employer Sponsored Regional (Provisional) (SESR) (subclass 494) visa: Evidence of a minimum of one year (minimum 38 hours per week if the approved AQF qualification was undertaken in Australia) employment experience as an Out of School Hours Care Worker in a regulated education and care service; or Evidence of a minimum of two years (minimum 35 hours per week) employment experience as an Out of School Hours Care Worker in a regulated education and care service.
	 For applicants applying for an Employer Nomination Scheme (ENS) (subclass 186) visa: Evidence of a minimum of two years (minimum 38 hours per week) employment experience as an Out of School Hours Care Worker in a regulated education and care service.
	 Expected responsibilities for all visa types during the employment include: provide education and care for children aged between 4 and 14 years prepare materials and equipment to support children's learning and development provide experiences to support children's play and learning ensure the health and safety of children support children to develop cooperative behaviour
Currency of Employment	The employment experience needs to have been completed after you were awarded your qualification. To ensure currency of skills, applicants need to provide evidence of at least six months full time (or part time equivalent) experience in the past five years.
